Thank you for giving to Lightwave!

Lightwave is a Christian community, meeting in small groups in homes, pubs, offices, schools and other places which works alongside more traditional ways of doing church.

While Lightwave has central funding for the main staff and their work until at least the end of 2024, a lot of the extra things we do can only happen through the generosity of members of our Lightwave Rural Hubs and Lightwave Groups. And when the funding comes to an end, we want to be able to continue to develop and grow what we do – so your giving is essential to that.

All money you give goes directly to the work of Lightwave, its groups and churches and hubs. Not only that, but as part of a registered charity, if you are a UK taxpayer, you can use Gift Aid to make your donations go further.

We've tried to make giving to Lightwave as easy as possible, with a range of options to suit you.

Online donations

You can give online from our website <https://www.light-wave.org/giving>

You can give either a one-off donation, or a regular donation, using a card or via direct debit. At the same time you can complete an online Gift Aid declaration without the need to download, complete and post off a form. There is a small percentage fee which the card processors make for using this service, so for larger or regular amounts you may wish to consider making a direct bank transfer – see below.

Standing Order and One-off Donations by bank transfer

You can also give by Standing Order or give a one-off donation by bank transfer. Details are on the form below.

Gift Aid

If you are a UK taxpayer, you can use Gift Aid to make your donations go further. We can claim 25p tax on every £1 that you give and it won't cost you a penny more. If you are making an online donation you can complete the on-line gift aid declaration – or otherwise all you need to do is complete the form below and send it to the

Lightwave Treasurer.
